

## **COMMITTEE ON THE EXAMINATION PATTERN OF TWO YEAR B.ED COURSE**

The Association of Managements of Private Colleges of Education has represented to the Council requesting for conduct of year-end examinations instead of semester system. A Committee to examine the request of the Association of Managements of Private Colleges of Education has been constituted with the following:

- 1 Prof.V.Sudhakar, Professor, Dept. of Education, English and Foreign Languages University, Hyderabad.
- 2 Prof.R.Srinivas Kumar, Professor, Dept. of Education, Dravidian University, Kuppam
- 3 Prof.T.Amuthavalli, Professor, Dept. Of Education, Sri Padmavathi Mahila Visva Vidyalayam, Tirupati.

The meeting of the Committee was held on 12.11.2019. The Committee examined the representation and also heard the views of the Association of Managements of Private Colleges of Education of A.P represented by its President and Associate President. The Committee recommended the following:

1. To continue the existing semester pattern of examination system in the 2-year B.Ed., programme in the State of AP.
2. To instruct the Universities and Colleges of Education to follow the 2-year B.Ed., Common Core Curriculum Guidelines including the students attendance, general rules of examinations, workload etc.
3. To instruct the universities to organise workshops for building awareness among Principals / HODs / Teacher Educators regarding semester system of curriculum and evaluation / examination.
4. To extend financial support to the universities for organising the above said workshops on semester system.
5. To advise the managements of private institutions / Colleges of Education to extend financial support / scholarships for the students who are in need.
6. To organise an interactive session between private managements of Colleges of Education including Aided Colleges, Government Colleges of Education, University Departments of Education, with APSCHE for developing understanding, smooth functioning and enriching the semester system in the 2-year B.Ed., programme.

The A.P State Council of Higher Education addressed a letter to the Government, endorsing the view of the Committee that the two year B.Ed course in the state of A.P shall continue with the semester system of examination pattern along with the report of the Committee.
