

Profile of CETs:

1. EAMCET

Engineering Agricultural and Medical Common Entrance Test, commonly called as **EAMCET**, is an [entrance examination](#) held separately in [Andhra Pradesh](#) for admission into various colleges in the streams of [Engineering](#), [Medicine](#) and [Agriculture](#).

The EAMCET is a yearly examination taken by a large number of engineering and medical aspirants in Andhra Pradesh State. Presently the [Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University, Kakinada](#) conducts AP EAMCET examination on behalf of APSCHE. This is the entrance exam for engineering ('E' category) and medicine ('AM' category: Agriculture and Medicine).

The qualifying percentage of marks in the Entrance Test is 25%, i.e., 40 out of 160. However, for candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, no minimum qualifying mark is prescribed. But their admission will be limited to the extent of seats reserved for such categories

2. ECET

Andhra Pradesh State Engineering Common Entrance Test (APECET) is a standardized entrance examination for Diploma and BSc Mathematics students to enter into [Bachelor of Engineering](#), [Bachelor of Technology](#) and [Bachelor of Pharmacy](#), programs in Andhra Pradesh. APECET 2020 exam is administered by Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University, Anantapur.

AP ECET enables Diploma and BSc Mathematics Students to enter into 2nd year of Undergraduate programs that include Bachelor of Engineering, Bachelor of Technology and Bachelor of Pharmacy in Andhra Pradesh State.

The exam is structured differently for Engineering Stream and Pharmacy Stream. Within Engineering Stream, the exam format differs slightly between Diploma students and Bachelor of Science Mathematics students.

The qualifying percentage of marks for obtaining a rank in AP ECET exam is 25% of the aggregate marks in the four subjects for diploma students and three subjects for B.Sc. (Mathematics, i.e., 50 marks out of a total of 200. However, in the case of SC/ST candidates, there shall be no minimum qualifying marks for ranking the candidates.

3. ICET

Andhra Pradesh Integrated Common Entrance Test (APICET) is a state-level [MBA](#) and [MCA](#) entrance examination conducted for admission to colleges in the state of Andhra Pradesh. APICET 2020 was conducted by [Sri Venkateswara University, Tirupati](#) on behalf of Andhra Pradesh State Council of Higher Education. APICET exam is conducted for 2 hours 30 minutes in online mode. The candidates have to take the exam at their respective exam centres. The question paper comprises 200 MCQs from Analytical Ability, Mathematical Ability, and Communication Ability. Admission through APICET is based on ranks secured in the exam. The qualifying cut off for General candidates is 50 marks out of 200. For SC/ST candidates, there is no qualifying mark's.

4. PGECET

Andhra Pradesh Post Graduate Engineering Common Entrance Test (AP PGECET) is a state level common entrance test for admission into regular PG Courses in Engineering, Technology, Pharmacy and Architecture & Planning (ME / M.Tech. / M.Pharmacy/Graduate level Pharm-D courses. This year it is conducted by Andhra University, Visakhapatnam on behalf of the Andhra Pradesh State Council of Higher Education (APSCHE). The test is a Computer based test wherein the candidate has to answer them online. The test will be in English medium and consists of 120 Marks with 120 multiple choice Objective type questions and the time allotted is 2 hours.

5. EdCET

A.P. Education Common Entrance Test (AP Ed.CET-2020) for the year 2020 was conducted by Andhra University, Visakhapatnam on behalf of the Andhra Pradesh State Council of Higher Education (APSCHE) for admission to **B.Ed. regular course** (two years duration) in the University/Government/ Aided/Un-aided/Private Colleges of Education in Andhra Pradesh for the academic year **2020-21**.

6. LAW CET / PGLCET

Andhra Pradesh Common Law Entrance Test (APLAWCET) is a state-level entrance exam conducted by Sri Krishnadevaraya University on behalf of **Andhra Pradesh** State Council of Higher Education (APSCHE) for admissions to law courses (3year LLB & 5 Years LLB) offered at **Andhra Pradesh** Universities and their affiliated colleges.

Andhra Pradesh Post Graduate Common Law Entrance Test (AP PGLCET) is a state-level entrance exam conducted by Andhra Pradesh State Council of Higher Education (APSCHE) for admissions to [LLM course](#). On the basis of AP PGLCET scores, candidates are offered admissions to various universities and their affiliated colleges of the state. The exam is conducted by [Sri Krishnadevaraya University](#) on behalf of APSCHE in an online mode.

7. PECET

A Common Entrance Test designated as Andhra Pradesh State Physical Education Common Entrance Test (AP PECET-2020) was conducted by Acharya Nagarjuna University for Academic year 2020-2021 for seeking Admission into B. P. Ed (2years) and UG D. P. Ed (2years) Courses.

8. APRCET

Andhra Pradesh Research Common Entrance test (APRCET) was conducted by Andhra University for admission into Ph. D (Full time / Part time) and M. Phil (Full time/ Part time) research courses in 14 Universities, campus colleges, research centres and identified affiliated colleges for the academic years 2018-2019, 2019-2020 on behalf of APSCHE, Tadepalli, Guntur.
