

NOTICES TO COLLEGES WITH ZERO/LESS THAN 25% ADMISSIONS AND WITHOUT AFFILIATION AND WITHDRAWAL OF PERMISSION TO PRIVATE UNAIDED DEGREE COLLEGES AND PROGRAMMES

The A.P State Council of Higher Education accords permission to establish Private Unaided Degree College in accordance with powers accrued vide G.O Ms.No.278 Dt: 24.07.1995 with a view to provide access to higher education and to improve Gross Enrolment Ratio.

The AP State Council of Higher Education issued show cause notices to the following categories of Colleges which are either not functioning or functioning without maintenance of standards in instructional and infrastructural requirements:

- i. Colleges which have not obtained affiliation from the respective University for the last three years
- ii. Colleges which have not made admissions for the last three years and
- iii. Colleges which have made less than 25% admissions for the last three years

Under the powers vested with the Competent Authority to review the subject matter under AP Education Act 1982, the Managements of the Colleges were directed to submit their written explanation on failure of the College for not making admission of students/less than 25% admissions during the last three years and to attend before an enquiry committee constituted by the APSCHE scheduled between 18.02.2020 and 25.02.2020. The members of the enquiry committee are:

1. Prof.T. Lakshamma, Vice Chairperson, APSCHE
2. Sri.T.V.S.Krishna Murthy, Joint Director, APSCHE
3. Sri.C.Sudesh Anand, Consultant (Law), APSCHE

The members of the Committee were requested to:

- a) Examine the written explanation submitted by the Management
- b) Verify the documents submitted by the College in accordance with the check list provided
- c) Record their observations/remarks in the checklist

The Managements of Colleges attended the enquiry and submitted their written statements. The Committee submitted its report on 14.10.2020. Based on the report of the Committee, the documents submitted by the Colleges and the written statements, the Council has withdrawn permission to 48 Private Unaided Degree Colleges and withdrawn certain programmes in respect of 61 Private Unaided Degree Colleges from 2020-21 for non maintenance of standards and not complying with norms. The details of Colleges to whom permission/programmes were withdrawn from 2020-21 are given hereunder:
